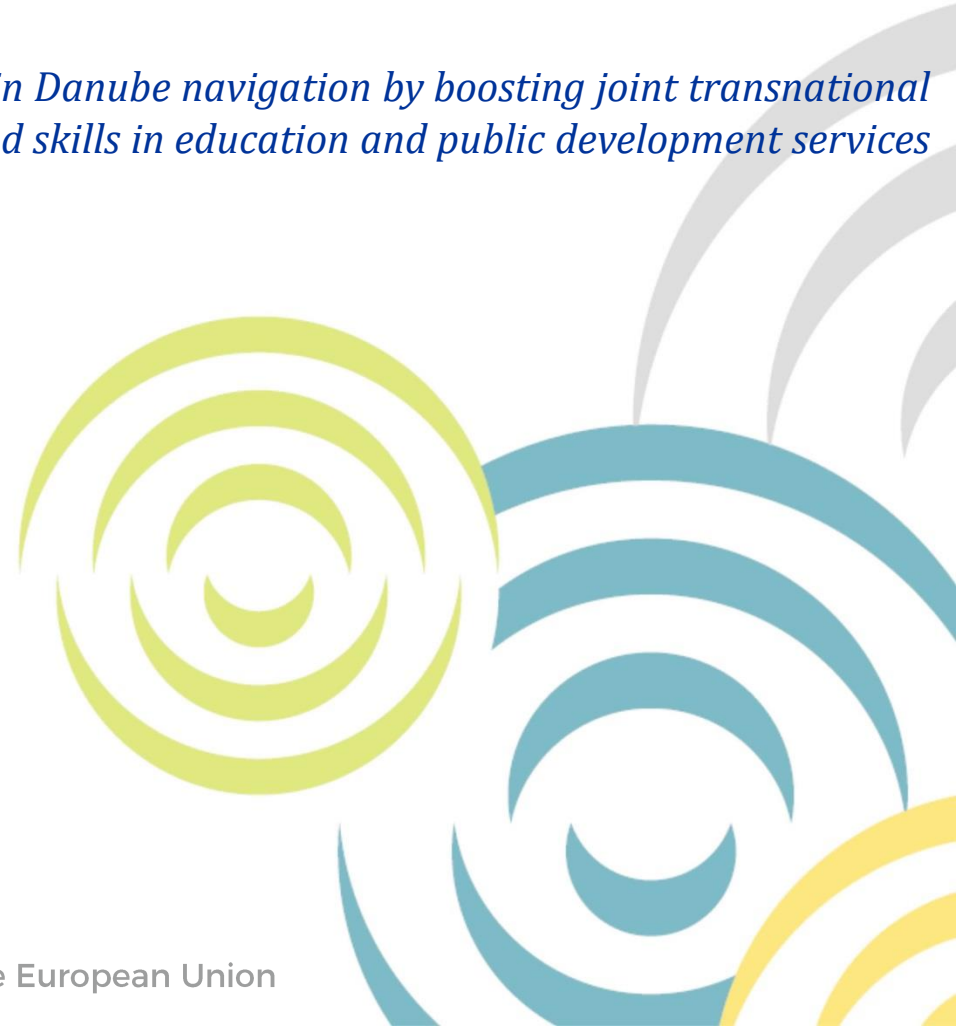

- ❑ Government of the Republic of Serbia formed PGA in 2013.
- ❑ Goal- to establish more efficient operation of water transport, especially inland ports and harbours.
- ❑ State administrative body with multiple roles in the development of water transport.



Regulatory role

- Suggesting laws and other documents to the Government
- Proscribing conditions that ports and harbours must fulfill

Professional role

- Determining the port areas for each port and terminal
- Issuing and revoking authorizations to port operators to conduct port activities.
- Keeping a register of port operators
- Charging port fees in accordance with the Law

Development role

- Development of port terminals
- Promoting of waterway traffic



Results

- 10 ports
- 2 harbors
- 3 passenger terminals
- Portal of electronic applications

Plans

- Declare all port areas
- Development of the passenger terminals
- Development of the IT (ILIS)
