PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT on the establishment of TRANSNATIONAL INNOVATION NETWORK (TIN)

Based on the activities under the ACCELERATOR project – "Developing accelerators to provide better access to innovation finance for SMEs" financed by the Interreg Danube Transnational Programme, project partners are establishing a Transnational Innovation Network (hereinafter referred as: TIN).

The parties referred to above have agreed to enter into the Partnership Agreement under the terms and conditions below:

Article 1 — Subject matter of the agreement

This Agreement establishes long-term cooperation within the Transnational Innovation Network, in order to deliver a new generation of innovation support services for the capacity building of Danube SMEs. Especially in the fields of access to innovation funding,



technology transfer, transfer of know-how, acceleration services and transnational collaborations.

The Agreement sets out terms and conditions, rights and obligations for the specific actions under the partnership

Article 2 — Rights and obligations under the partnership

The partners shall obey the objectives of the partnership and implement it as described in the Operational Model for the Transnational Innovation Network, the Code of Conduct, and endeavour to accomplish objectives also in the specific actions.

The partners shall maintain relations of mutual co-operation and regular and transparent exchange of information with the Network partners on:

- the implementation and follow-up of activities defined in the Operational Model for the Transnational Innovation Network and
- other matters of common interest related to the Partnership Agreement.

Article 3 — Specific actions to be implemented

Specific actions to be implemented are set out in the Operational Model for the Transnational Innovation Network.

Article 4 — General obligation for proper implementation of specific actions

The partners must implement specific actions as described in the Operational Model for the Transnational Innovation Network and the Code of Conduct.

Article 5 — Resources for the implementation of specific actions

The rules on the resources for the implementation of specific actions and involvement of third parties in the actions are set out in the Operational Model for the Transnational Innovation Network.

Article 6 — Termination of the partnership agreement

The partners have the right to terminate the Partnership Agreement at any time.

The partners who decide to terminate the Partnership Agreement must formally notify other partners on their decision to terminate the Partnership Agreement, whereat stating the date the termination will come in force.

Neither partner may claim damages due to termination by the other partner.
