Since 1995, 977 buildings in the capital have been registered into the “Register of monuments of national and municipal importance”. Many of them lack upkeep measures, leading to neglect and decay. To tackle this issue, the Urban Regeneration Agenda presents guidelines and solutions for the revitalization of forgotten spaces, such as the BUCIUMUL Centre.

Founded in 1992, the BUCIUMUL Center is a former movie set located in central Chisinău. The center has had the aim of showcasing national history, art, and cultural heritage.
