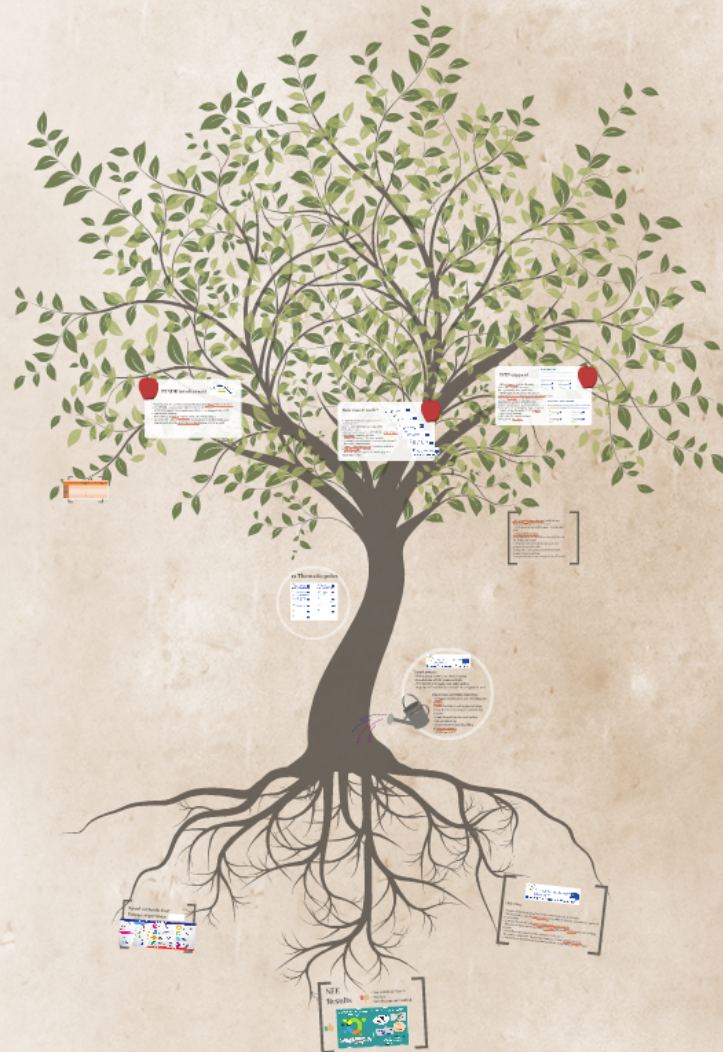

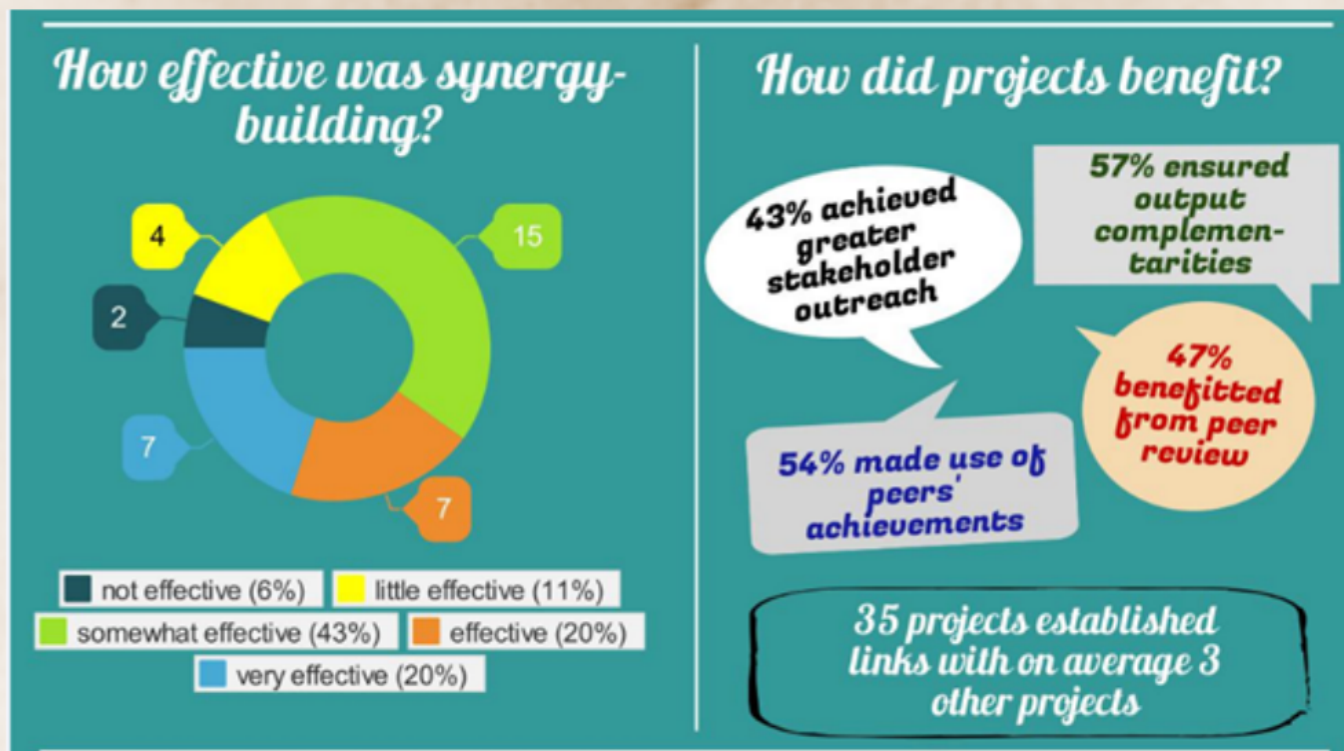

Objectives:

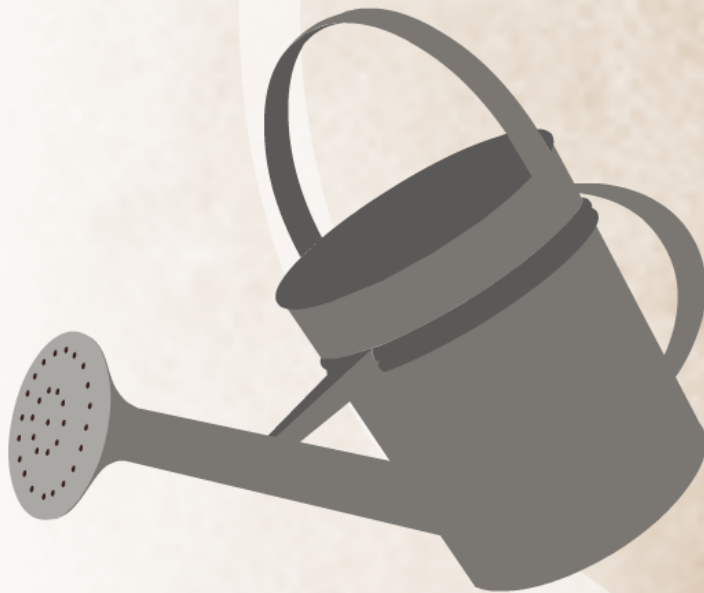
- Valorise/build upon knowledge from projects in a thematic field

EUSDR involvement



- Poles identified according to project themes and in line with Priority Areas of the EUSDR » a way to streamline activities with EUSDR
- All EUSDR Priority Area Coordinators (PACs) were informed about DTP Capitalisation Strategy
- PACs invite to be Pole co-leaders during the whole process
 - » good link with other programmes and stakeholders in the Danube area
- Specific session in the 6th EUSDR Forum (Budapest, 18-19/10/2017)

How does it work?

- 1) Applicants included Capitalisation in their proposals
- 2) 54 + 22 approved projects grouped into 12 Thematic Poles
- 3) For each pole: 1 project + 1 EUSDR PAC → Pole leaders
- 4) Roadmap created by each Pole
 - Identified synergies + Foreseen activities
- 5) Communication (First joint events already organised)
 - Synergies → Capitalisation
- 7) Open to other programmes → Invitation email sent
- 6) Dynamic nature of the poles
 - New DTP projects approved + outside projects/stakeholders to join



DTP support

- DTP projects: core of the Thematic Poles » they own the process of synergy-building and capitalisation
- DTP JS supports the process in terms of communication, coordination and monitoring the Poles
- Several meetings organised for Poles to meet: Lead Partner seminars, EUSDR Forum (plenary presentation + working groups), Pole leader/PAC training (Budapest, 28/06), etc.
- Launch of specific section in DTP website
 - » updates on Pole pages
- DTP will collect and disseminate Strategy/Pole outcomes

DTP CAPITALISATION STRATEGY

We, the Danube Transnational Programme (DTP), are one of the successors of the South East Europe (SEE) Cooperation Programme. It was us back then to design a Thematic Capitalisation Strategy which capitalised on the knowledge of the 122 SEE projects.

Now, the DTP has designed its own DTP Capitalisation Strategy, which is thriving in a new context, differing to the SEE in a few aspects.

THEMATIC POLE 4 - WATER MANAGEMENT

Four projects are cooperating in the framework of Thematic Pole 4 in connection to water management. While the projects address different issues like steering land use to safeguard water resources and reduce flood risk; coordinating sediment management along the Danube river; developing an integrated river basin and flood risk management plan for the Tisza River Basin; Improving drought monitoring, management and emergency response in the Danube Region; they seek for synergies for the common benefit.

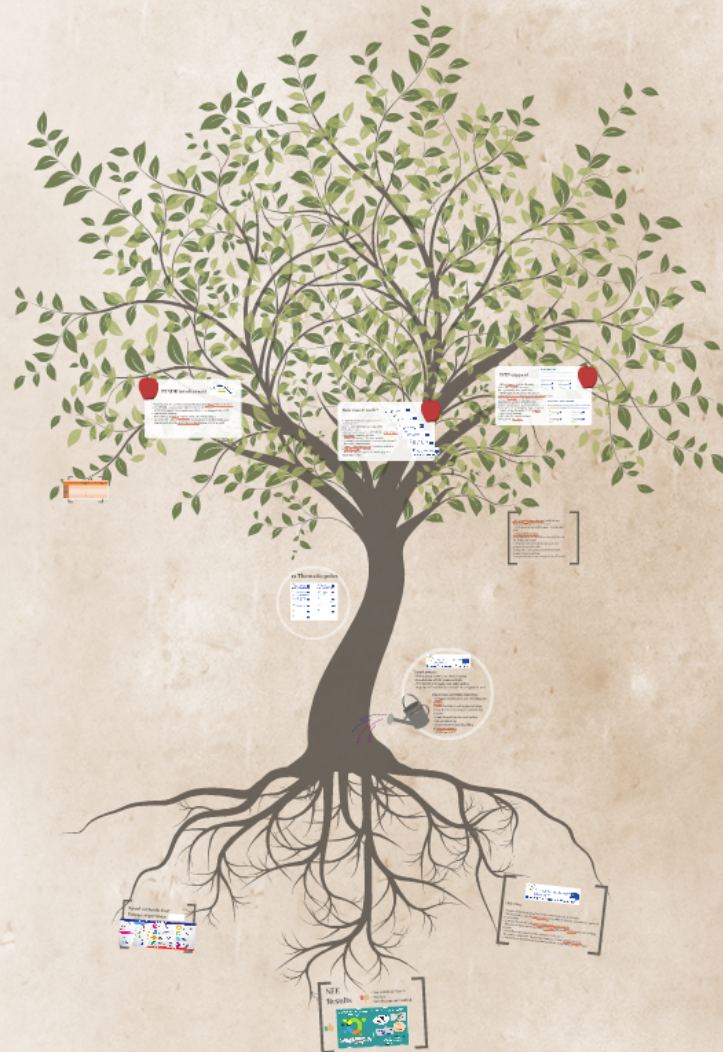
