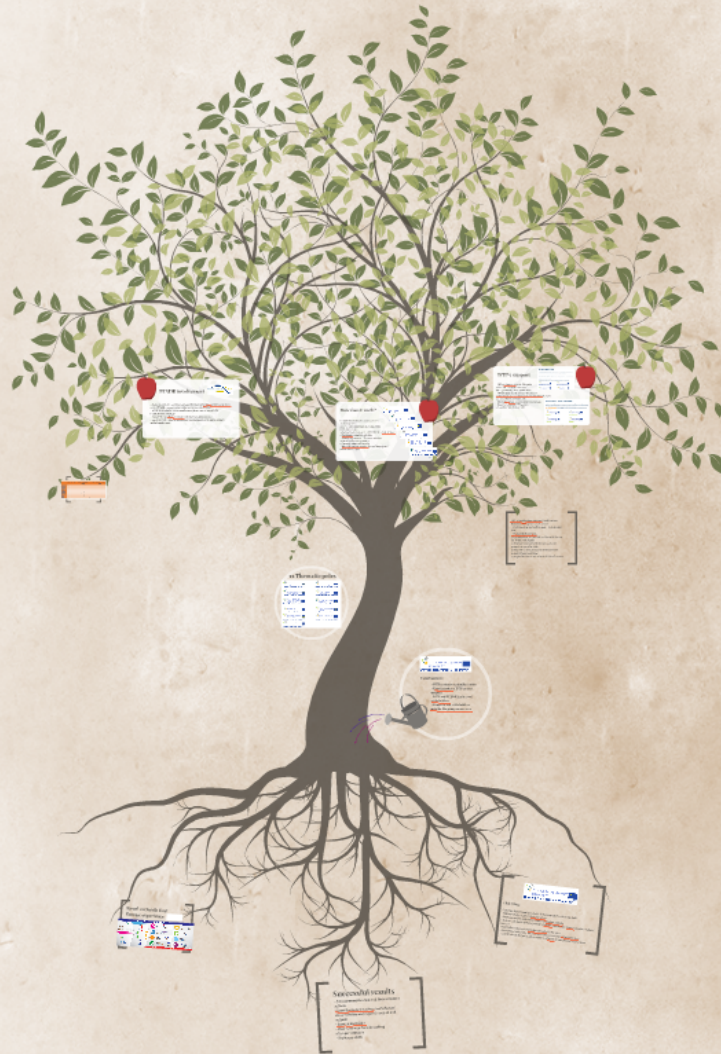

Objectives:

- Valorise/build upon knowledge from projects in a thematic field
- Fill knowledge-gaps by linking actors
- Increase quality and sustainability of project outputs
- Increase projects and programme visibility and ensure impact on policy making process
- Strengthen strategic thematic networks in the area
- Encourage wider take-up of project outcomes from outside the area
- Contribute to design/implementation of future transnational cooperation

How does it work?

- 1) Applicants included Capitalisation in their proposals
- 2) 54 + 22 approved projects grouped into 12 Thematic Poles
- 3) For each pole: 1 project + 1 EUSDR PAC → Pole leaders
- 4) Roadmap created by each Pole
 - Identified synergies + Foreseen activities
- 6) Open to other programmes
- 7) Dynamic nature of the poles
 - New DTP projects approved + outside projects/
stakeholders to join

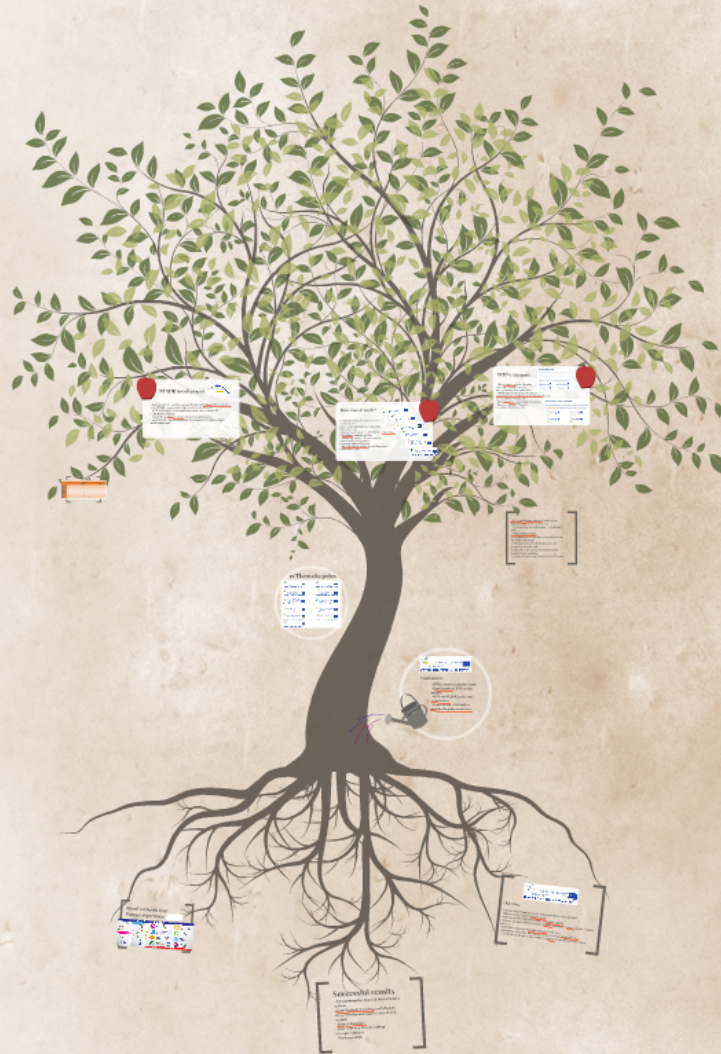
EUSDR involvement
